Luggage requirements

- Ryan air cabin luggage – one small bag no bigger than 35cm x 20cm x 20cm and one piece not exceeding 10kg and no bigger than 55cm x 40cm x 20cm including the handles pockets and wheels.

Dress Code for the Vatican

- Strictly prohibited

Low cut tops, shorts, sleeveless tops, cropped tops, hats and ripped jeans.

Long sleeves and long pants required



Code of Positive Behaviour

- Students must be respectful at all times
- All directions/instructions given by teachers must be followed
- Students must be punctual at all times

- Students must pay €10 room deposit. If a student is late for the bus in the morning or is out of their room after the agreed time they will forfeit the €10. If these rules are not broken, deposit will be returned on the last morning.
- Breach of any rules will result in the imposition of serious sanctions.
- The above conditions will apply and must be signed by both parents and students.
